Make the first impression a good one and help your horse optimize how it eats hay.

Slowly introduce grazing hay through the net. Put some hay in the OptiMizer and pull tufts through various locations to help them get started.

If your horse is hungry, feed some additional hay in their previous way or sprinkle loose hay on top of the OptiMizer.

During the first few weeks, we recommend that you check the condition of the net each day. In the unlikely event that you spot a hole forming, repair it promptly with twine or a zip tie. The net will last longer if there is always a little hay left in the OptiMizer because a hungry horse will grind the net into the bottom of the feeder to extract every bit of hay.

The OptiMizer was designed to maximize safety for horses and their caregivers. Please use caution when using the OptiMizer. It is possible for halters, fly masks, muzzles, blankets and/or horse shoes to get entangled with the netting. It is possible that a horse could injure itself on the OptiMizer. Discontinue use if the OptiMizer becomes cracked or broken.
